Bradford City Heritage Trail



Look for the wild boar's head on Bradford's crest and on buildings in the City Centre.





In 1873, this magnificent public building was built to look like an Italian palace with an impressive 61-metre-high bell tower. It is decorated with 35 statues of English kings and queens. The building contains the council offices, a banqueting room and a police museum, based in the original Victorian police station, cells and courtroom.
